ABOUT:

The inner world of each of us constantly beats through two other symbolic spaces – private and public. We defined the first one with the word family. Whatever that means, it is inherently based on trust. The public world is everything else, and we set countless rules to survive together in it. Rules that are not always related to the word truth. But if the family is also full of innocent lies, it becomes a social institution of distant individuals. Communication is a manipulative game, dishonesty is a habit. As children, we grow up in this microcosm, and without realizing it, we suddenly lie to our class teacher, doctor, auditor, boss, friends.

With the exhibition Portrait of a Family, David Bartoš debates what a lie can mean and where its meaning boundaries are. Using the example of one family, he examines the consequences of everyday decisions based on intentional or unintentional denials of the truth. It follows the "what ifs" - which we usually don't allow for self-preservation - and weaves the fates of individual members into a story made up of several parallel universes.



# Eduspacemotionthings

#### ABOUT:

In 1971, Robert Morris, an American conceptual sculptor, prepared the exhibition Bodyspacemotionthings for Tate Modern in London. This exhibition was a great success, even though it was a relatively risky project because the content and theme of the whole work was the game. The exhibition was playing with what art is as it should be perceived. It was a game with the spectator, a spectator game with the exhibition, it was playing as such because the installation was represented by interactive geometric elements made of wood.Half a century later, an exhibition was created in Lubná u Poličky in Kulturák Archa, which stems from a similar concept of the game. This element shifts from the perception of art itself to its education, and asks a question of how art can be educated. Therefore the prefix of the title of the exhibition is modified from Body into Edu-spacemotionthings.Eduspacemotionthings presents a horizontally participatory project by David Bartoš, an artist and teacher at the Secondary School of Design and Fashion in Prostějov, and his students. Together, they try to find a way through the possible game and mutual creative dialogue to find ways of mutual education through a practical artistic act-exhibition.



In addition to the social context, the work has a therapeutic dimension, not only for that one family and its members, but also for others. Every family has its problems, like every social group where there is interaction. The viewer thus has the opportunity to reflect on the problematic topics shown on himself and his relatives.



# Kosíř

ABOUT:

In 2016, 100 years have passed since the beginning of Dadaism, a direction that, among other things, was based on the absurdity. I found an absurdity in our society, specifically in today's tourism, which has transformed under the weight of the capitalism, which always brings entertainment and services. Tourism, which was content with footpaths, forests, hills and campfires, has become tourism with lookouts, buffets, secured routes, rope centers and other products of a mass society craving for experience and entertainment. Nature alone is no longer enough. I have come across this absurdity everywhere, but it touches me the most in the Velký Kosíř hill, which is the only hill in Haná region and I have it a few kilometers from my house. Since 2012, an asphalt road leads to the hill, which climbs to the top with a lookout tower, a buffet and a hut with a grill. I organized a happening. From the local quarry (at the foot of the hill) we brought 78.5 kg of stones to the top. Afterwards, we took these stones back to the quarry and made a fire with spekacky saussages. The output of the work was an audio recording, which captures what I consider to be the most important in tourism - the existence of a person (friends) in the nature. Also attached to the work are diary entries that describe my trips to Kosír, during which I tried to find undiscovered paths and nooks and crannies. Idealized drawings of the Kosír landscape were subsequently added to the diary entries. The 2nd edition of the magazine Umělec Pitomec was published as a theoretical part of the topic. The work was created as an installation resulted in an exhibition at the Rainbow Gallery in Prostějov. At the opening, people received snacks for the journey.

## Miroslava Večeřová: Where the Sea Swallowed a Woman

#### ABOUT:

The current exhibition project of the artist Miroslava Večeřová presents the author's latest work including objects, large-format drawings and video performances inspired by the environment of the cliff coast of southern England, where the author regularly spends her time. Her experience with the local ecosystem led her to reflect on the mutual coexistence between living and non-living organisms in her immediate surroundings, as well as the materials (primarily minerals) that she often uses as the basic raw material for her new creations.

Miroslava Večeřová (1985) studied photography at Camberwell College of Arts in London and the Academy of Applied Arts in Prague in the studio of Alexandra Vajd and Hynko Alt. In his work, however, he does not limit himself to photography as his means of expression, on the contrary, he works intermedially. Through a language made up of images, objects and performance, he explores the interrelationships and connections between human and non-human existence, including animals, plants, minerals and hitherto unknown entities. He currently lives and works in England.



# Festival of Contemporary Art Prostějov **FSUP 2021, 2022**

The festival of contemporary art was created on the initiative of Prostějovské natives from among the cultural and artistic community, who have been continuously implementing a regular or occasional cultural program within various artistic and educational institutions since 2016. The festival once a year (usually in the first half of October) over the course of three to four days presents artists and artistic groups and their work, which reflects contemporary artistic trends and social issues and phenomena.

The aim of the Festival was and is to connect various artistic, exhibition, educational and leisure institutions within the framework of the intensive festival genre and, within their possibilities, to present contemporary art in the form of exhibitions, performances, projections, installations, discussions, workshops, concerts and other cultural and artistic forms.

The curatorial concept is based on the principle of openness and diversity, which stems from the preferences and focus of individual curators. The conditions for the selection of male and female artists and artistic groups therefore consist primarily of demands for the quality and topicality of the selected artwork. Thanks to this approach, the festival takes on the role of a platform, on the basis of which representatives of contemporary artistic creation meet, who rely on various content and formal sources or are part of different opinion and social groups of the

# XY walk **Pilsen in Olomouc**

The XY project, which was created in 2014 as a joint initiative of Olomouc curators, offers exhibition hosting to authors from a selected artistic environment in a unified exhibition opening date. The traveling show has the character of a series of successive vernissages of contemporary art connected by a walk - the whole thing takes place in one afternoon in the center of Olomouc. Individual exhibitions then continue in duration according to the possibilities of their galleries. The curators of the selected galleries have been representing the independent art scene in Olomouc for a long time, and within the framework of the XY show, they most prominently enter the professional and lay public.



# Kristína Kandriková Ticho před svítáním


In her work, Kristína Kandriková has long been concerned with being human in a landscape shrouded in darkness. In paintings and object (and sometimes also sound) installations, he reflects his own experiences from night meditations, errands and runs, which he realizes mainly around his native Kysucké Nové Mesto. For this, he uses his own characteristic visual language, tending towards minimalism and abstracting the raw conditions and experiences of being at night.

She opened the existential theme for the first time in 2018 in Prostějovská Gallery Cyril with the exhibition Krajní Bdění. The yonder tower and the ground of the church turned into a forest, which is slowly disappearing in the gloom of the twilight. A year later, she dragged the viewer into the deepest night. In the darkness of the Medium Gallery in Bratislava, Kandrik made the viewer see things that are not there and not see things that are there.

In Plzeňská Truhlárná (DEPO2015), Kandriková logically concludes this inner journey by coming to light. The exhibition as a whole reflects one of the most magical moments of our days – the transformation of darkness into light, the time when night turns into day. As pathetic as it sounds, it is a moment that carries archetypal themes and meanings grasped within philosophies, religions, and ultimately art. Before the first rays fall, there is Silence. As if everything alive felt and breathed for the first time. And with the first exhalation comes light, at first gentle, almost invisible, and then suddenly violent - orange, yellow, green, blue, red. They change colors depending on what the world is like.

And precisely fragments of the landscape of our world, which is being prepared for light (and subsequently bathed in it in various forms), Kandriková grasps and abstracts within the framework of her characteristic language in an installation of objects, images, sounds

Although there is a natural tendency to reflect climate change and the problems of our environment within the framework of the artistic operation, Kandriková does not primarily aim in this direction. Apart from his own inner confession, he points out the problem of human coexistence with everything else on Earth. If our forests are on fire, fields are dry, glaciers and snow are a thing of the past, and animals are only an obstacle or a tool in the cycle of consumption, then man also suffers from all these ailments. Behind all the problems of today is not only irrationality and consumerism, but also the interruption of the natural close relationship between man and the landscape. Sometimes you just need to dive into the dark to understand again what the light looks like.

# **Cyril Gallery**


